CSPA West Mercia Group came into being in February 2022. The Group currently has nearly 900 members residing in Herefordshire, Shropshire and Worcestershire. CSPA nationally has about 47,000 members.

Our next West Mercia Group meeting is on Monday 20 March 2023 at 2.00pm at The Quaker Meeting House in Sansome Walk, Worcester (round the corner from Worcester Foregate Street Station). It will be preceded by a light pub lunch from 12 noonish at The Crown in Broad Street. We meet again on Wednesday 22 March 2023 at 1.30pm at Shrewsbury United Reform, Coleham Head. These two meetings will constitute our Group AGM, when will elect our Group Officers and the Accounts Auditor for the coming year and review the Annual Statement of Accounts for 2022. Our meetings in Hereford and Worcester begin at 2pm, and those in Shrewsbury and Wellington begin at 1.30pm. The meetings are conducted fairly informally and last no more than 2 hours. They end with a refreshing cup of tea or coffee.

The Charity for Civil Servants (CfCS)

CfCS, formerly called the Civil Service Benevolent Fund, helps retired, current, and former civil servants with whatever problems they may have. Its vision is of a lifelong civil service community - of people offering effective support for each other when life takes a turn for the worse. The help includes financial assistance and a range of services, including help with bereavement, residential care, relationships, caring, dementia, long-term illness, and other emergencies.

CfCS works with specialist organisations – including Macmillan, Dementia UK and Relate – and signposts other sources of advice when appropriate.

Visit its website www.foryoubyyou.org.uk or call its confidential helpline on 0800 056 2424. CfCS is **not** a membership organisation, so all retired, serving or former civil servants are eligible to apply for its help. We hope to have a CfCS speaker at one of our Group meetings this year.

National Pensioners' Convention (NPC)

CSPA is affiliated to the **National Pensioners' Convention**, the largest pensioners organisation in the UK. It campaigns for and promotes the welfare and interests of all pensioners, as a way of securing dignity, respect and financial security in retirement. NPC organises rallies, and lobbies of MPs, and makes submissions to Government on policies affecting older people. It has a Biennial Delegate Conference, which last met in March 2022 to elect the national officers and determine its policies for the coming 2 years. NPC also stages an annual 2-day "Pensioners' Convention" in June in Blackpool.

NPC's monthly bulletin "Campaign" is sent by the Group Secretary to the 140 members of our email group. Anyone else can visit the NPC website at https://www.npcuk.org to receive it. The latest edition covers Dignity Action Day on 1 February; the leaked plans to advance by several years the date when State Pension age will reach 68; the Prepayment Meter scandal; the demonstrations seeking an end to Winter Excess Deaths; the threat to charge £20 to people who visit a hospital A&E instead of a GP, and £10 for missed GP appointments; and the impact of closure of High Street banks and ATMs.

Our Group is proud to be affiliated to NPC's regional organisation, the **West Midlands Pensioners Convention** (WMPC). We send at least one delegate to their monthly meetings in Birmingham.
